

How to find RIPA International



By National Rail or London Underground: The nearest mainline station is **City Thameslink Rail**. If you are arriving at one of London's other mainline terminals you are advised to use the London Underground to Chancery Lane (**Central Line**) or Holborn (**Central Line, Piccadilly Line**). These are all within easy walking distance of our offices by following the directions given below.

City Thameslink Station: Start out along LUDGATE CIRCUS, heading north. After 15 metres continue onto FARRINGDON STREET, heading north. After 43 metres bear left onto ST BRIDE STREET, heading west. After 150 metres bear left onto LITTLE NEW STREET, heading west. After 100 metres turn right onto NEW STREET SQUARE, heading north. You'll soon pass CITY RHODES RESTAURANT. After 100 metres bear left onto BARTLETT COURT, heading north. After 45 metres turn left onto NEW FETTER LANE, heading south. After 11 metres turn right onto PLOUGH PLACE, heading north. After 62 metres turn right onto FETTER LANE, heading north. You will reach your destination 30 metres along FETTER LANE.

Chancery Lane Station: Start out along HOLBORN, heading east. You'll soon pass LOMBARD ODIER (UK) BANK, EGG PRUDENTIAL BANKING, pass MELTON MOWBRAY BAR OR PUB and then pass ROYAL BANK OF SCOTLAND. After 150 metres turn right onto FETTER LANE at HSBC ATM, LEISURE LOUNGE NIGHTCLUB, heading south. You will reach your destination 100 metres along FETTER LANE.

Holborn Station: Start out along HIGH HOLBORN, heading east. You'll pass PRET A MANGER COFFEE SHOP, pass CHANCERY COURT HOTEL OR MOTEL, pass BOOKS ETC BOOK STORE and then pass CAFFE MERO COFFEE SHOP. After 3/4 kilometre continue straight onto HOLBORN at CHANCERY LANE UNDERGROUND STATION, heading east. You'll soon pass LOMBARD ODIER (UK) BANK, EGG PRUDENTIAL BANKING, pass MELTON MOWBRAY BAR OR PUB and then pass ROYAL BANK OF SCOTLAND. After 150 metres turn right onto FETTER LANE at HSBC ATM, LEISURE LOUNGE NIGHTCLUB, heading south. You will reach your destination 100 metres along FETTER LANE.

By Road: Drivers are advised that traffic in London is extremely congested and you will need to pay the congestion charge in advance of driving. We recommend that you use public transport wherever possible. However, if you wish to arrive by car, please speak to our Programme Co-ordinators about the congestion charge and parking.
